When to Call

When is the right time to call?

- Are heart medications no longer effective in managing your symptoms?
- Do you have significant shortness of breath that results in a decreased ability to do the things you want and need to do?
- Have you had repeated hospitalizations?
- Do you have pain, anxiety, swelling, fatigue, or insomnia?

If any of these are true for you, call us now—we are ready to help. We will contact your doctor and meet with you to determine the right time for services to begin. The sooner we become involved, the sooner we can help.

HeartWise can help individuals who generally have:

- Class IV Heart Failure, causing severe limitations.
- Shortness of breath with minimal exertion.
- A need for increased supplemental oxygen.
- Poor response to diuretics and vasodilators.
- CHF: fluid overload despite medications.
- CAD: history of angina, arrhythmia or MI.
- Chest pain present even at rest.

HeartWise will build an individualized plan of care by:

- Developing a personalized plan of care to help you live each day to the fullest.
- Aggressively working to reduce distressing symptoms.
- Reduce/eliminate unnecessary hospital and emergency room visits.
- Providing you and those closest to you with care, support, education and peace of mind.
