Understanding Concurrent Care

Pediatric concurrent care allow for both palliative services and curative or specialized treatments to occur simultaneously, improving the experience while navigating challenges. Concurrent care is available through Medicaid and most commercial insurances for children under the age of twenty-one who have been diagnosed with a life-limiting illness. This specialized care provides an added layer of support for the child and family, allowing for greater comfort and stability for the child and family. The goal is to manage symptoms at home whenever possible, reduce hospitalizations, and maintain stability and comfort in familiar surroundings.
